1. Ask God to forgive you for all of your sins (1 John 1:9).
 2. Pray to the Father in Jesus' name. Make specific requests "...Let your requests be made known to God" (Phil. 4:6). You can always add "If it be Your will" on the end of a prayer if you don't know the will of God. Making a list sometimes helps.
 3. Place your trust in His promises, specific Scriptures. Trust in who God is, in His integrity, and in the integrity of His Word.
 4. Thank God and praise Him for what He *is doing according to His will* "...with thanksgiving..." (Phil. 4:6).
